Introduction

This document is intended to serve as a User Manual for grant of the service "Authorization under Construction and Demolition Waste Management (Management and Handling) Rules, 2016" by West Bengal Pollution Control Board, Govt. of West Bengal through Single window of the State, 'SilpaSathi'. The service is integrated with the Single Window (SilpaSathi) and can be accessed through the SilpaSathi portal. This document has been designed as a user-friendly guide to assist applicants in filling their application forms. It will help them to familiarise with the entire procedure in a seamless manner for successful submission of application and download final Approval certificate from the SilpaSathi portal without the requirement of physical visit to the Department(s).

Salient Features of Silpasathi Portal:

- The Single Window Portal of the State of West Bengal (SilpaSathi) allows seamless integration with portals of different government departments thereby providing single login credential for various applications, eliminating the need to provide common information multiple times in different forms of various Departments, and ensuring all clearances are available from a single portal.
- It serves as a digital gateway for providing the necessary statutory compliances under the applicable Acts, Rules, Policies and Schemes of the Govt of West Bengal from a single portal.
- Business Entrepreneurs can get certificates and licences required for setting up and operating business in the State
 in a smooth and time-bound manner, smooth and time-bound manner, without the need to visit any government
 department or office.

About the Service

The Authorization under Construction and Demolition Waste Management (Management and Handling) Rules, 2016 is a set of regulations issued by the Government of India to manage and handle construction and demolition waste. The service aims to minimize waste generation, promote recycling, and ensure environmentally safe disposal. They cover various aspects, including waste management plans, authorization for handling and processing, and guidelines for recycling and reuse of construction materials. The rules also provide penalties for non-compliance and encourage the development of sustainable waste management practices in the construction sector. The online system has the following features without the requirement of physical visit to the Department: 1) Submission of Application 2) Online Payment of fees 3) Track Status of Application 4) Online Download of final approval certificate 5) Third Party Verification.

Comprehensive Checklist of Documents to be submitted online

The applicant is required to submit the following documents in order to apply for the service:

#	Documents Required	Detailed Description
1.	Copy of CTE granted by WBPCB	The West Bengal Pollution Control Board (WBPCB) grants a Consent to Establish (CTE) to industries, plants, or processes before they are established.
2.	Copy of CTO granted by WBPCB	The West Bengal Pollution Control Board (WBPCB) grants Consent to Operate (CTO) to industries and operating units after considering their compliance with environmental laws
3.	Site Clearance of local body	Site clearance is a process that involves removing trees, walls, and previous buildings from a site to prepare it for construction
4.	Copy of agreement between operating agencies and local bodies	A copy of an agreement between operating agencies and local bodies is a document that outlines the terms and conditions of collaboration between various agencies responsible for operating and maintaining infrastructure, such as transportation systems, public utilities, or community facilities, and local governing bodies



1. Online Application submission along with online submission of documents


In order to complete the user registration, the applicant has log on to https://silpasathi.wb.gov.in/ and click on 'Apply online' button.



<u>Applicant Log-in</u>: The applicant needs to **select the required category** as illustrated in the screenshot below and **proceed for registration**.





Applicants will receive email confirmation after registering into the single window portal. Please refer to the screenshot below:












After clicking on 'Apply Online' option, the applicant shall be redirected to the main application form. The applicant will have to fill in the required details and review the application form (screenshot below):





The applicant /user shall be notified via SMS and email on his registered phone number and email id respectively. The applicant receives notifications at different stages of the application - application submission, application approval, etc.






2. Track Status of Application





















5: Third Party verification details


Third party verification is a process by which any independent user / third party verifies an individual's license and registration details online check authenticity of the Certificate without logging into the portal.

The applicant or any user has to log in to https://silpasathi.wb.gov.in/.


A user (any third party) needs to click on '*Third party Verification*' section in the homepage and enter registration number / license number and then click on 'Search' link, for Verification of Certificate.




